GENERAL RULES
1. TDA Rules apply in all PokerAtlas Tour events.
2. Buy-in is \$200(Prize Pool) + \$70 (Admin) + \$130 (Bounty Pool).
3. Unlimited re-entries available through the close of registration (start of level 9) for \$400.
4. 1-IN-8 (12.5%) will be in the money.
5. Blinds will increase until the completion of the tournament.
6. This tournament will have a "Big Blind Ante", the big blind will be paid first, the ante will not reduce.
7. This event will be played 9-handed.
8. This Event is played with a "Mystery Bounty" format, meaning that once players are in the money, every participant remaining will receive a wrapped "Gift Box" containing an unknown amount of money in each box. The \$ value of each mystery gift will be determined by the number of entries in the event, after registration is closed. At minimum, there is guaranteed to be one mystery gift of at least \$5,000. The process for issuing participants their "Gifts", will be done by a random 2-step process. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 8.1 Once in the money, when a participant knocks someone else out of the tournament, they will collect their opponents "Gift" and have the option to open a) that gift, b) their own gift, or c) someone else's gift at your table. 8.2 If a participant steals someone else's gift, they must open that gift.
